Among the new citizen centric policies are Traffic Violation with videos shown to educate the violators of their violation apart from fining, sharing of his personal WhatsApp number, Facebook and Twitter accounts for citizens to make complaints direct to him, Khataras – Seizure of old vehicles lying on the roads and footpath for long periods, revival of ALMs and Mohalla Committees in each Police Station, Looking after Senior citizens under the jurisdiction of each police station, and of course the most popular and well received by citizens the SUNDAY STREETS where all over Mumbai certain streets would be free of vehicles from 6 am to 10 am to allow citizens to indulge in various activities like, yoga, sports, dance etc. Finally the formation of Mumbai Citizen Forum.

While his name is doing the rounds for a three-month extension, Mr. Pandey has denied asking for extension.

Pandey took a tough stand after taking over as commissioner in the conflict between the Central government and state government, but the MVA government is said to be unhappy with his 'public welfare' approach. The state government is therefore not sending a proposal for an extension. Further they would like to have someone of their choice, in view of the forthcoming BMC elections.

The question the citizens look forward to is, will the new commissioner continue the citizen centric policies?

## BMC publishes final electoral ward reservation, makes no changes in draft

After the Supreme court order on May 4, the State Election Commission (SEC) directed BMC to conduct further process of election

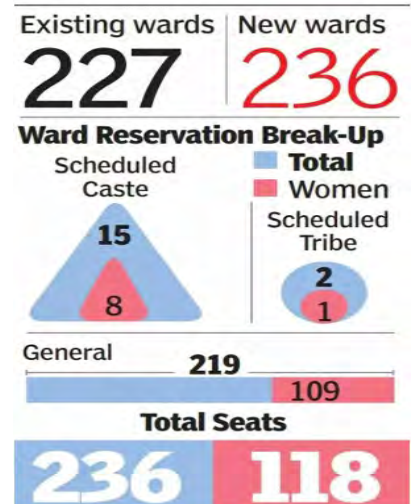
Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) has published the final electoral ward reservation through notification. However, BMC has not made a single change in the final electoral ward reservation draft. Opposition party has condemned the BMC and entire process of suggestion and objection.

After the Supreme court order on May 4, the State Election Commission (SEC) directed BMC to conduct further process of election. Accordingly, a lottery was drawn for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST) and general category seats for women, without Other Backward Class (OBC) seats, on May 31 for the BMC at Rangsharda auditorium, Bandra where 118 wards were kept reserved for women candidates. 15 seats were reserved for scheduled castes and 2 seats for scheduled tribes. Among 15, 8 seats will be reserved for SC women candidates and one seat for SC women candidate. The draft of the ward-wise reservation was published on June 1.

As per the SEC advise, suggestions and objections window was open till June 6 and hearing was to be held, but the BMC published its final draft without making any changes.

With this, the BMC has completed both the delimitation and reservation process for each seat.

Now, a ward-wise voter list will be prepared. The suggestions and objections can be raised in case any area is left



out of the electoral list. "This exercise should be completed by July 7 with the final voters' list being published.

While the final ward reservation was published, officials said they may have to redo the ward reservation lottery in case the Supreme Court directs the BMC to hold elections while including the OBC quota. An official said, "Even if we are asked to do the ward reservation process, the SC/ST seats will not change."

The former Corporators are unhappy with the way the reservations were done and not taking suggestions and objections and with no hearing being called as advised by SEC before publishing the final draft. Ravi Raja, the Opposition leader in BMC and congress corporator plans to go to the court against the reservation.

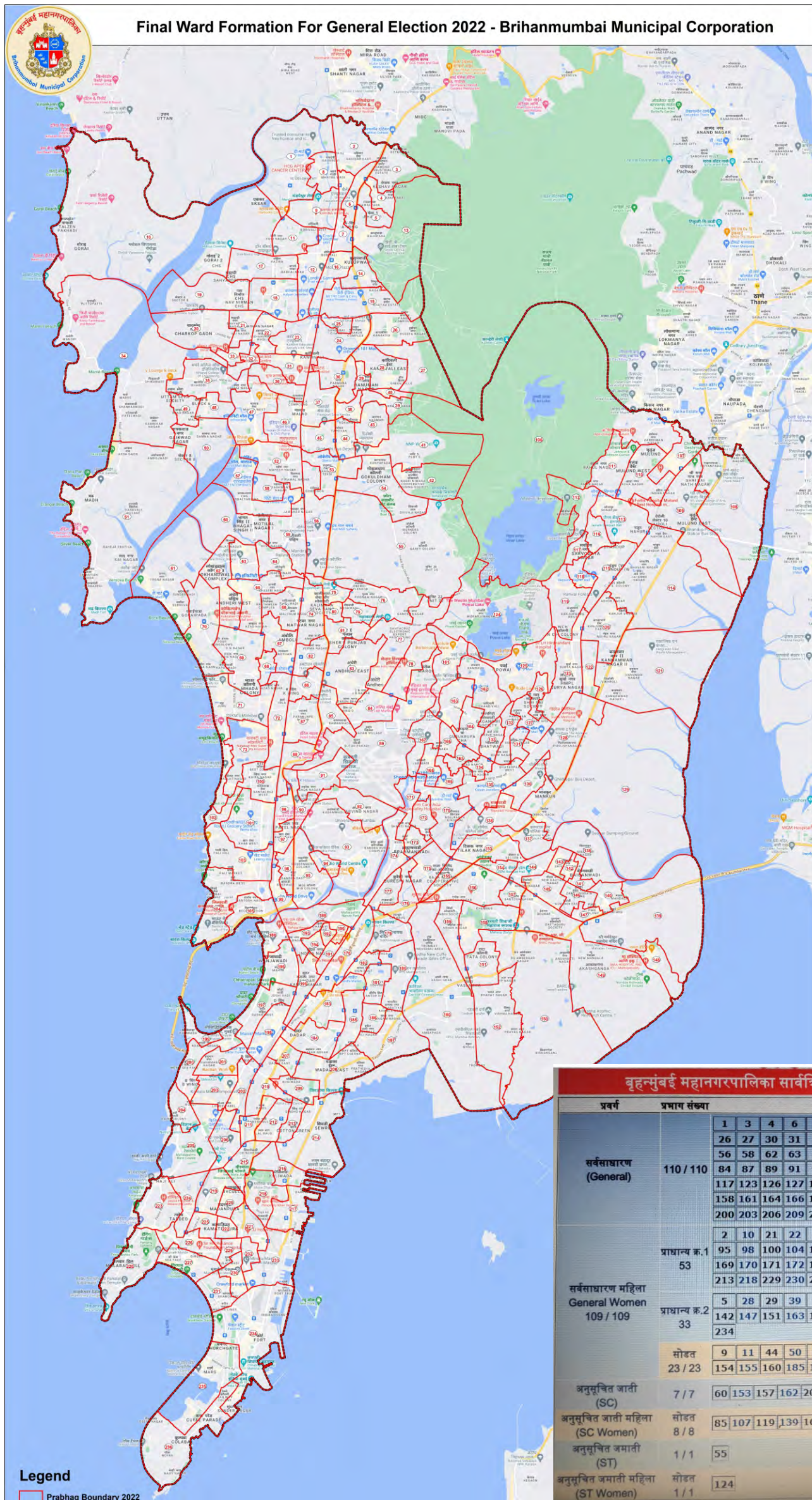

## Add civic chief to Ward Officers: Walk the talk on anti-encroachment

To rid the city's footpath of encroachments, BMC's newly appointed commissioner (city) Ashish Sharma has instructed ward officers to visit streets in their respective wards every week and take necessary actions wherever required.

The conditions of footpaths are a clear indicator of how concerned the BMC is about its citizens. Things always start improving when you focus on them and these small changes can make a big difference. He has instructed ward officers of some areas to inspect streets in their areas for the next few days. The BMC is already working on improvement of footpaths on the Andheri-Ghatkopar Link Road. But the work on Western Express Highway metro station to Saki Naka junction is facing several hurdles in the form of unauthorised parking and encroachments.

The BMC has decided to repair

and beautify footpaths in three municipal wards of Andheri (West), Borivli and Dahisar to make them encroachment free and pedestrian friendly. Two years back the civic body had taken up beautification work of footpaths in some of the heritage precinct areas in south Mumbai. In October last year, the BMC roads department identified 33 different

locations in south and central Mumbai for carrying out improvement works on footpaths.

The corporation had replaced the existing paver blocks with cement and concrete footpaths in all these projects. **MMJ**
